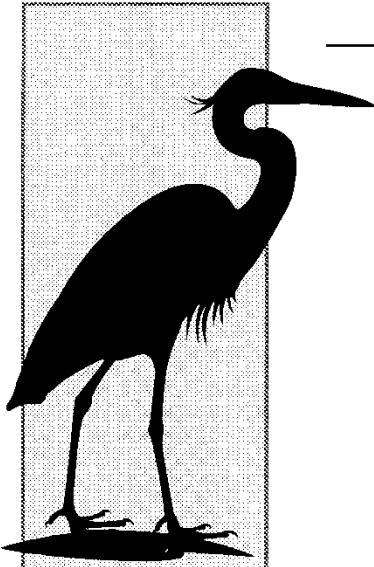
Recap of last meeting.
